See you in April - Be sure to bring your family, neighbors & friends - the more the merrier! Town's 2024 Budget Finalized -Fiscal Year Begins April 1, 2023

Here are some highlights:

- Public hearing held on 3/13 on the draft budget - budget approved at 3/17 Town Council Meeting
- \$12,780,000 in revenue and \$10,938,000 in operating costs; \$890,000 in capital projects; and \$246,000 in debt repayments
- Changes to fees parking from \$2.50 to \$3.00/hr & tickets from \$40 to \$50; and an increase in shuttle fees - will provide \$450k increased revenue to help with increasing entertainment costs; waiving \$.25 fee for trolley
- Increase in property tax by 3% (first time in 4 years) - would be about \$23/yr increase for property owners
